

Parent Code of Conduct-After School Program

We, The Town of Rochester, have implemented the following parent code of conduct to ensure the safety of all children and staff in our After-School Program at all times. Parents must read, understand and sign this form in order to continue participation in this program.

Any parent guilty of improper conduct at any time will be asked to leave the premises and their children will no longer be able to participate in the after-school program.

Improper behavior is any behavior that is violent, threatens violence, coerces, harasses, or intimidates others, interferes with an individual's legal rights of movement or expression, disrupts the workplace, or the Town of Rochester's ability to provide services to the youth under our supervision. Examples include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Disruptive behavior. (yelling, using profanity, verbally abusing others, or waving arms and fists in an aggressive manner.)
- 2. Respect personal space. Adults shall NEVER put their hands on a child in our program.
- 3. Intentional physical contact for the purpose of causing harm.
- 4. Menacing or threatening behavior toward youth or adults will not be tolerated. (Examples include; throwing objects, acting aggressively or stalking.)

The Town of Rochester expects all participants, parents and staff to adhere to these rules and also exhibit the following elements of character and ethics: Trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring and good citizenship.

Thank you for your cooperation and understanding. Our goal is to provide the safest possible environment to all participants in the after school program.
