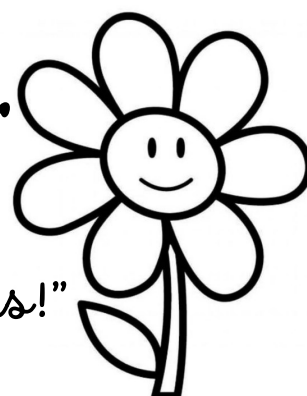

Valid ID required.*

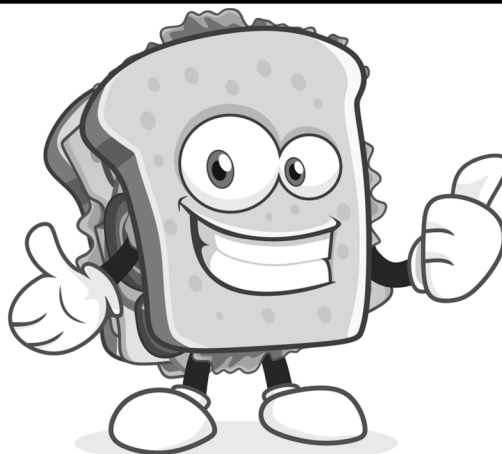
